Hello MPA Families,

Well, it is March! This means it is time for parent teacher conferences. After a year of pandemic disruption, this is a good time for parents and teachers to connect. You, as a parent, probably have questions such as; *How is my child growing academically? How is my child growing emotionally?*What are the next steps in their development in the next three months? What are some key works we can do to support my child at home to be ready for next school year? These four questions can easily fill a 30-minute conference. Each teacher has a conference process to answer as many questions as possible and define the next steps. Please look for conference sign-up information from your child's teacher. Finally, remember the most effective parent-school relationships are collaborative and respectful. Thank you for taking the time to talk about your child and what it means for their future.

What will school be like next year? Great question! The answers are slowly coming this Spring. For parents who are considering a remote option for their child or children next year, we, at MPA, will discuss this issue at the next MPA Board meeting on March 16. If you could give us a few more weeks to make decisions before deciding to enroll in the Jeffco Remote Option program, that would be great. Stay tuned!

Jefferson County is now in the Blue range of the COVID Dial. This is welcome news, however, it doesn't change much at MPA on our health and safety protocols. Our current process is keeping the school open, and we will continue mask use, health screeners, and social distancing as much as possible. Currently, about half of the MPA staff has had the first shot in the

vaccination process. Getting the MPA Staff vaccinated will help us keep children safer and have less staff quarantines, which means less disruptions to the school and more learning. Hopefully, we will continue to see more declines in the virus positivity rates as the Summer approaches. Thank you for wearing your mask while on the MPA campus.

**What are Guidelines for Remote Learning?** Remote Learning is not a drop- in service. We will inform you if your child is eligible to join remote learning on a temporary basis. Students who will need to be out of school for continuous days due to illness or who are in quarantine will be placed in remote learning. Here is the list of reasons to join remote learning:

- Waiting on test results (1-3 days) Lead teacher sends home paper & pencil work.
- Pre-Arranged Personal Vacations Lead teacher sends home paper & pencil work.
- Quarantine more than 3 days (personal vacations do not qualify) students will report to Erin (LEL) or Todd (UEL), and they will include them in lessons that go with the work they have in progress already from their Lead teacher. The Lead teacher will inform the remote teachers that your child is joining remote learning. The Lead teacher will send home work and materials. The Lead teacher has informed Erin/Todd what your student is working on (not a class quarantine; just a single student quarantine).
- Extended absence (more than 3 days) same as quarantine

**Quarantine Information:** If you have more than one student at MPA, and one of them has a class quarantine, your other student may attend school unless they or their sibling at home develops symptoms.

<u>Pending COVID Tests:</u> Please remember that if either your student OR any household member has a pending COVID test, they must stay at home until the results are in. Also, please get a PCR test if you do need a test. We cannot accept most rapid test results, and you will need to get another test if it's not a PCR test. Your student may not return to school until they are completely symptom free. Stuffy, runny noses and cough can be uncomfortable in a mask.

**Don't Forget Your Health Screener Form!** Remember! You will need to fill out your form before your student may come into the building. If you need more screeners please ask your classroom teacher or click on the below link to download and print at home.


