Hello MPA Families,

October is one of my favorite months of the year! October brings colored leaves to the trees, a change in the weather, baseball playoffs and Parent/Teacher Conferences. By this time of the school year the teachers have learned many things about your child or children. This is a perfect time to connect and share and plan your child's academic and emotional goals, together. One of the greatest skills of Montessori teachers is how they observe the classroom and the habits of students. At your conference you can expect to learn about your child's:

- Recent academic progress
- Behavioral development
- Social interactions in the classroom
- Strengths and challenges within the learning environment.

Parents, you bring incredible valuable information to the conference by:

- Explaining your child's attitude towards learning and school
- What may be currently impacting your child's learning and emotional growth
- Describing your child's strengths and weakness
- Providing more information about your child's special interests and joys in life
- Struggles from the pandemic

Remember at this time of year, the conference is a replacement for the traditional academic report card. Being prepared as a parent will help facilitate a smooth and informative conference. Report cards will be going home at the end of each semester, which means early January and early June. Frequent and open communication is a wonderful way to learn about your child's school day and develop a stronger relationship with your child's teacher and being an advocate in their life development.

Look for communication about scheduling time to meet with a teacher either in person or by Google Meet during the month of October. Happy Conferencing!






